Indian Economy on the Transformational Paths

India's business activity reaches three-month high in November. India's business activity surged in November, reaching a three-month high of 59.5 on the HSBC Flash India Composite Purchasing Managers Index (PMI), compiled by S&P Global. This marked an increase from October's 59.1 and stayed above the long-term average, driven by rising new orders and export sales. The services sector saw a notable uptick in activity, with its PMI climbing to 59.2, the highest in three months. While slightly down from October's 57.5 to 57.3, manufacturing exceeded expectations, bolstered by robust expansion in new orders and international sales. Gains were reported across Asia, Europe, and the Americas.

India will become one of the top 10 global shipbuilders by 2030. Union Ports, Shipping, and Waterways Minister Sarbananda Sonowal announced India's ambitious maritime aspirations at the 'Sagarmanthan—The Great Oceans Dialogue'. Addressing the event, he revealed that India is poised to become one of the top 10 shipbuilding nations by 2030 and to ascend to the top 5 by 2047. "With its abundant talent pool and resources, India is well-equipped to emerge as a leading shipbuilding nation," he remarked. India's maritime industry handles approximately 95% of the nation's trade by volume and 70% by value. The infrastructure includes 12 major ports and over 200 notified minor and intermediate ports, pivotal in sustaining the country's economic growth.

Gen Al to add up to US\$438 billion to GDP. Speaking at the DEPR Conference on 'Digital Technology, Productivity and Economic Growth in India' held in Jaipur, RBI Deputy Governor Michael Debabrata Patra projected that generative AI could inject between US\$359 billion and US\$438 billion into India's GDP by 2029-30. This economic lift is attributed to India's expanding digital public infrastructure, a leading IT sector, and one of the largest AI talent pools worldwide. The adoption of AI by Indian firms has sharply increased, from 8% in 2023 to 25% in 2024, showcasing the country's rapid digital integration into production processes.

India to launch European Space Agency's Proba-3 mission. India will launch the European Space Agency's (ESA) Proba-3 mission in December, marking a significant step in international space collaboration. The mission will deploy two satellites, launched aboard ISRO's PSLV-XL, into a high elliptical orbit that will reach 60,000 km from Earth. Proba-3's twin satellites will maintain an autonomous formation to allow uninterrupted observation of the Sun's corona, achievable only through precise, millimetre-level alignment. The launch is scheduled for December 4 from Sriharikota. This is ESA's first launch from India since the Proba-1 mission in 2001, highlighting the growth in space cooperation between India and Europe.

India's export grows, driven by gems, semiconductors

According to recent data from the Commerce Ministry, India's export competitiveness has witnessed notable advancements over the last five years, particularly in petroleum, precious stones, agrochemicals, and sugar. This growth has been marked by a surge in the country's share in global trade across these sectors, alongside other segments like electrical goods, tyres, and semiconductor devices. Petroleum exports saw a significant increase, reaching US\$84.96 billion in 2023. This positioned India as the second-largest exporter globally, a leap from its fifth rank in 2018, with market share swelling from 6.45% to 12.59%. India has claimed the top spot in the precious and semi-precious stones category by expanding its share from 16.27% to 36.53% between 2018 and 2023, driven by an export value boost from US\$0.26 billion to US\$1.52 billion. Semiconductor and photosensitive device exports surged to US\$1.91 billion in 2023, propelling India's rank from 25th to 9th globally.









Commemorating the Constitution Day of India

Constitution Day also known as 'Samvidhan Divas', is celebrated in our country on 26th November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26th November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India, which came into effect from 26th January 1950. The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment on 19th November 2015 notified the decision of Government of India to celebrate the 26th day of November every year as 'Constitution Day' to promote Constitution values among citizens.



Chess has the youngest world champion in history, and he is from India



The era of India's GM Gukesh Dommaraju as chess world champion began, after an incredibly hard-fought 2024 FIDE World Championship in Singapore suddenly ended when the Chinese reigning champion GM Ding Liren blundered in the final classical game. We look at some of the conclusions we can draw from an event that may prove to be a turning point in chess history. The 2024 FIDE World Championship came to an end in Singapore on Friday with the closing ceremony, which you can rewatch <u>here</u>. He's four years younger than the legendary GM Garry Kasparov was when he took the title from GM Anatoly Karpov in 1985, with Kasparov in turn a few months younger than another candidate for the greatest of all time, GM Magnus Carlsen, who won the title in 2013 from India's first world champion, GM Viswanathan Anand.




Ambassador Goel visited the Island of Krk


